

## **DCPS COVID-19 Testing Information for Parents**

DCPS follows DC Health Student Testing Guidance which outlines two testing options for students in DCPS schools. Schools will provide rapid COVID- 19 testing to students identified as having potential COVID-19 symptoms while at school and DC Health will conduct regular testing of asymptomatic students to help ensure parents and students at their schools remain safe for in-person learning.
