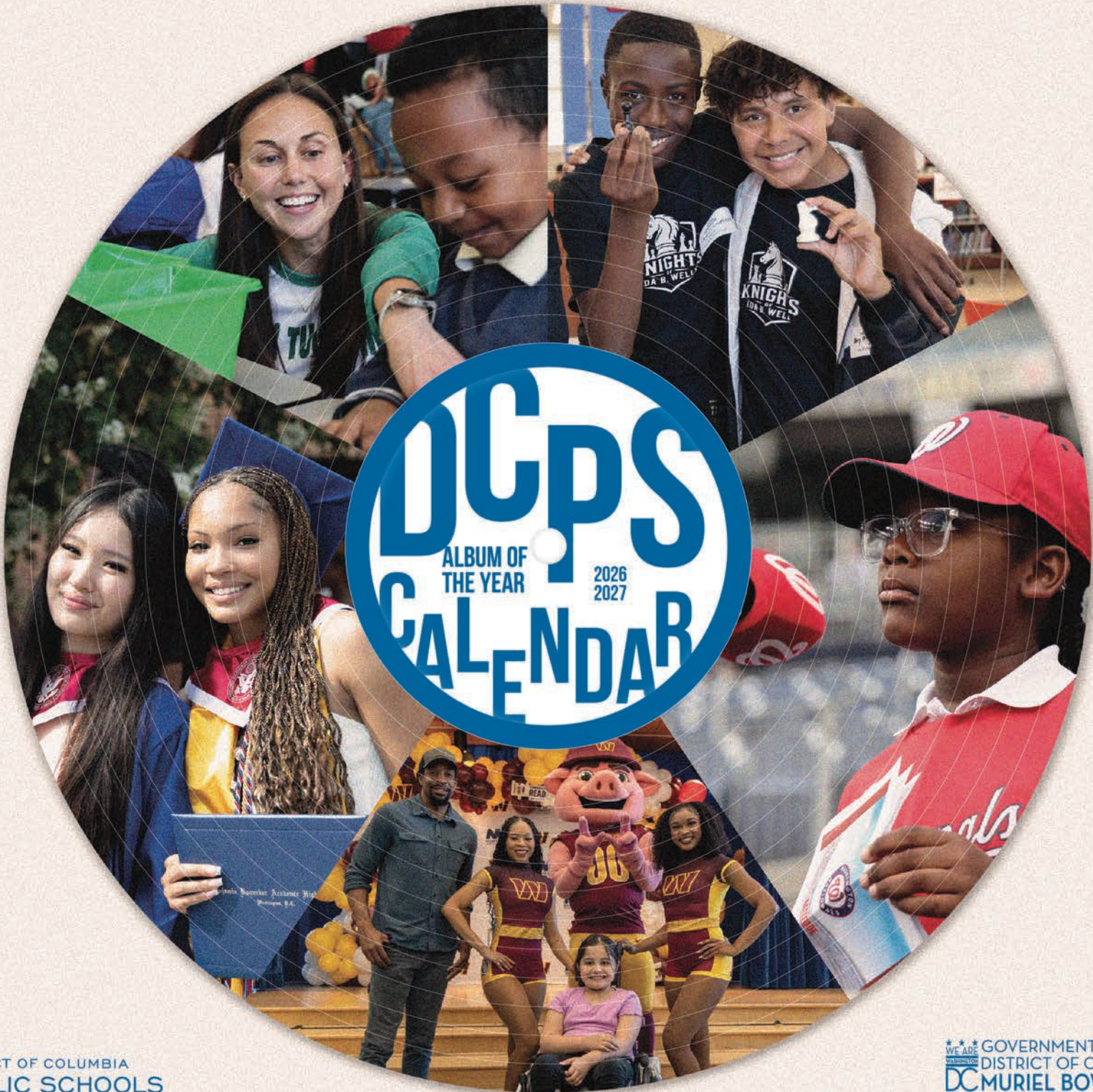

This includes observances that occur on weekends.
